

CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF VALEDICTORIAN, SALUTATORIAN AND HONORARIAN

The criteria for valedictorian, salutatorian and honorarian will be the seniors with the highest cumulative grade point averages who have been in attendance at Teays Valley Christian School for the entire four years of high school. The cumulative GPA is calculated using all high school courses (8th grade Algebra and all courses in grades nine through twelve). The status of valedictorian, salutatorian or honorarian is determined after the first semester of the senior year and may be revoked if the student's GPA drops in the second semester. To be eligible to graduate as valedictorian, salutatorian, or honorarian, students must take physics or calculus during their senior year. Only students who have completed coursework for the honors diploma will be eligible.

CLASS RANK

Academic ranking of students will be done by grade point average only. In the event of a tie, the same rank will be awarded.
